CHARACTERISTICS & USES

CARMYBOND 66 is suitable for excellent bonding of PVC tiles or moquettes with foam backing on floors or walls covered with cement, mosaic, mortar, wood or metal. It is also recommended for bonding insulating polystyrene foam.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Clean throughly and roughen (if possible) both surfaces. Spread the adhesive on one the surface of the floor to be bonded by using a toothed spatula. Bond by pressing the surfaces after 15-45 min in purpose to avoid buubles. After 1-2 hours press again the surface's ends that might be not bonded .Maximum bonding is achieved after 48 hours. Mixing at the material is advisable before each use.

STORAGE

CARMYBOND 66 can be stored for at least 18 months at a temperature of 20°C in well closed cans.
